### HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Ramada Plaza Hotel has been selected to host delegates and serve as the venue for the workshop. The hotel is beautifully positioned on sandy beaches on the Coast of Carthage and not far from the airport and center of town. ACBF has settled hotel accommodation for participants, on bed and breakfast basis. Any additional room charges or services (room refreshment bar/service, laundry, telephones, etc.) will be covered by the participants. ACBF will cover all expenses related to the participant's travel (ticket, visa and per diems), as per ACBF rules and regulations. The ACBF daily subsistence allowance rate for Tunis is USD 94.

### TRANSPORT TO AND FROM THE AIRPORT

The hotel will provide airport transfers for all participants.

### FORMALITY FOR ENTRY IN TUNISIA

**Visas:** A valid passport and visa are required for entry into Tunisia. ACBF in collaboration with the African Development Bank (AfDB) is responsible for granting a visa letter to delegates to facilitate entry into Tunisia. Please carry the visa letter with you when travelling.

**Health Regulations:** Vaccinations against yellow fever is required for entry into Tunisia.

### LOGISTICS

**Registration:** Your information package including name badges can be obtained from the Secretariat Office located at the Hotel.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION ON TUNISIA**

### **LANGUAGE**

Arabic and French are the official languages of Tunisia.

### **TIME ZONE**

Standard time zone is (GMT +1 hour).

### **CURRENCY**

Currency in Tunisia is the Tunisian Dinar. Major credit cards are accepted in some hotels and banks. All foreign currency must be cleared when entering Tunisia.

### **CLIMATE**

Climate in Tunisia is mediterranean along the coast with winter months of November to March. Temperatures range between 8°C - 18 °C. Participants are recommended to bring warm clothing for the duration of the workshop.

### **SECURITY TIPS**

Petty crime may be present in major cities of Tunisia. Visitors should exercise caution at all times, stay alert and always be aware of their surroundings. Avoid large crowds which may turn violent. Participants are advised to seek information from the hotel's information desk, and clearly defined information offices or from the Secretariat.
